BURIALS AND CREMATION MEMORIALS

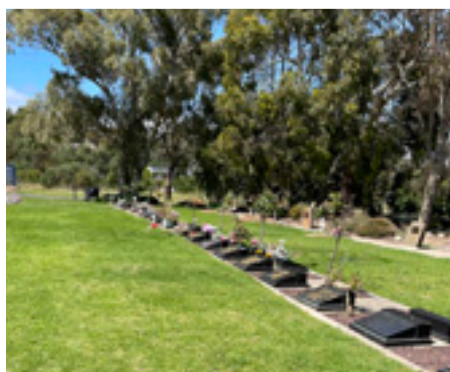
There are a few plots available in the old section of Willunga cemetery, but none at Normanville. There are no plots available in the Rose Garden sections at Willunga. Plots in the Beams and Vault sections at Willunga and the New Section at Normanville are readily available.

The Beam Sections at Willunga have upright monuments mounted on a beam. Height and width restrictions apply. The graves are dug in front of the beam. The vaults in the Vault Section at Willunga are sealed with a concrete lid and full monumental work. The vaults measure 2200mm x 800mm x 815mm deep. The New Section at Normanville has full-size graves with ledger and monuments no more than 1 metre high.

Niche walls, for the interment of cremated remains, are available at both cemeteries. Once the remains are placed in the walls, a standard-sized bronze plaque is fixed in place to cover the niche. The Native Tree Section at Willunga has small upright monuments mounted on a beam. The Gazebo Memorial at Willunga caters for cremated remains, which are interred in this area and a bronze plaque is fixed to the seating around the sides of the gazebo.

Tenure for earth burial leases is 99 years. Tenure for cremation memorial leases is 50 years.

All enquiries regarding burial and memorial sites must be directed to the Curators of the Parish cemeteries. The fees and costs were revised recently and the new pricing is current from 1 February, 2024.
